

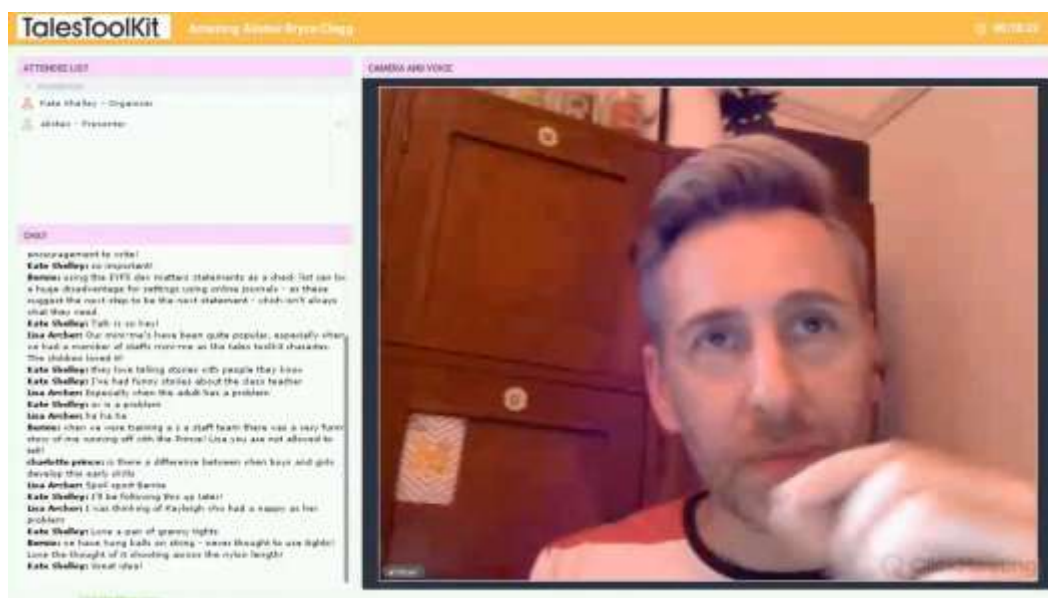
What is a webinar?

A webinar is a live, web-based conference. At Tales Toolkit, our founder Kate chats with lots of top experts live online and you can come along and get involved! You can type questions and comments that everyone attending the webinar can see, including Kate and the speaker. It's a great way of engaging with top experts without the cost of a conference or supply teacher and you can even watch from the comfort of your sofa in your PJs with a bottle of wine! (that sounds like a big bonus to us!)

We've previously had the amazing Alistair Bryce Clegg, the magnificent Mine Conkbayir and the renowned Dr Julian Grenier (plus loads more) discussing topics from expression of early education through arts, to the connection between social development and neuroscience! You'll never get a webinar like the last, and the insight gained from each one is truly priceless, a really wonderful resource!

Each webinar will consist of a short introduction by Kate, our founder, a presentation by the speaker, followed by time for questions at the end. You'll see each speaker chat live and they may use videos, photographs and PowerPoints to illustrate their topics better, or they'll follow a more conversational pattern, paying attention to any comments you type during the talk. The speaker may also share links that you can follow to further research their topic of discussion.

While the speaker is talking you're free to comment and ask questions. Our host Kate will be keeping track of any questions that the expert can't answer and will bring them up during the Q&A session at the end. Plus, there'll be lots of other practitioners attending the webinar that you can chat with and learn from during the event.



1. You'll see our founder Kate and the expert talking
2. The expert might show you PowerPoint slides, photographs or films
3. You can type while watching and Kate, the expert and the rest of the people can see your comments and questions and chat with you.

We run webinars regularly, focusing on different aspects of early years learning, development and teaching that link with Tales Toolkit, whether that's boys' writing, OFSTED or social and emotional development. We post information in advance on our social media pages, website blog and we'll send an email to all those on our mailing list.
