

How to join a Tales Toolkit webinar

We'll post the registration links for our webinars on our social media platforms and in our newsletters before the event. You can't register too early!

All you need to do is click the link, and you'll be directed to a page that looks like this:

This email contains the date, time, location and website address of the webinar. Beside the time will be noted the time zone; if you're signing up from a different time zone it may show two different times in your email, double check your time zone to be sure. There will be a link in the email to add the event to your diary which might be useful (I know it helps me remember!)

NOTE: You might need to download Flash Player to be able to watch the video. The email will also contain a button at the foot of the email that looks like this:

When you have completed registration and it is the evening of the webinar, make sure to click the green 'join' button in your email as it will invite you into the waiting room so you're nice and ready for it to start! If this button doesn't work, the email gives you a couple of different options so don't panic! We have had feedback that using google chrome can solve any problems you might have logging in. Make sure you arrive early, especially for your first webinar to make sure you can log in. You can get into the waiting room at any point before the event so feel free to try it out before the day.

Our webinars are limited to 50 people and it's first come, first served on the day for all those registered so we recommend you come along early.
